SUMMER MONDAY TEAM TUMBLING

On Monday evenings beginning June 10 through August 12, Mini, Pee Wee and Pony cheerleaders will work on tumbling skills at the USA Stars Gym, 27 Fairview St. in Carlisle. All participants must pay an annual \$40 USA Stars insurance fee at the first tumbling session on Mon, June 10th and a weekly \$5 tumbling fee to the tumbling coaches. We also encourage cheerleaders to attend USA Stars open gyms on Saturdays (\$8 per open gym) which are designed to practice and reinforce the skills learned in classes. There are also open gyms at Cheer Tyme and Flipping Out Tumbling. Cheerleaders need to tumble at least one time per week to maintain skill level. To learn new skills or advance, cheerleaders must tumble a minimum of 2 to 3 times per week. The more a cheerleader tumbles, the better! Parents, please plan carpools in advance.

PRACTICES

Being a CV youth cheerleader requires significant commitment, but brings with it endless rewards. As the saying goes "practice makes perfect" so it stands to reason that attending all practices is the first step toward a successful season. In cheerleading, each participant has a unique role in the team's football line-up or competition routine that can only be performed by one specific individual. There is no second string or "bench" for our teams. In order for a team to practice, cheer at games, or compete, cheerleaders must be willing to make personal sacrifices and attend ALL practices so they are able to work together as a team to achieve their goals. Attendance at all practices is mandatory. CVYCA reserves the right to make changes to team rosters based on poor attendance or financial standing.

Team practices for the new season begin on Thurs, Aug 1st rain or shine with a parent meeting in the Good Hope Auditorium at 6 pm. Summer practices will be held from 6-7:30 pm on August 1, 6, 13, 14, and 15 at Good Hope Middle School. The summer practice schedule allows for 4-day weekend "getaways" to the beach and to visit relatives. Once school begins, the Pee Wee and Pony teams will practice on Tuesdays and Thursdays at CVHS and either Saturday or Sunday (depending on FB games and competitions) at USA Stars; Mini teams will practice Mondays and Wednesdays; and the Rookies will practice on either Monday or Wednesday. During Monday tumbling at USA Stars in June, tumbling evaluations will be held for Minis, Pee Wees and Ponies to determine team placement. Placement will be **based on tumbling skills and level of interest**. The final day to demonstrate a skill to the advisors will be Monday, June 24. During registration, parents will have the opportunity to indicate level of interest and commitment on the registration forms.

FOOTBALL GAMES

The actual football schedule will not be available until the end of May or June. If the schedule is like last year's, the CVMFA football games will be played primarily on Sundays with the possibility of one or two Saturday evening games. Home games will be played @Stoney Ridge, 50 Bernheisel Bridge Rd, Carlisle. Last year, the order on game day was Midgets, Ponies, Pee Wees, and Minis with specific times announced during August. The schedule will vary per cheer team and large cheer teams may be split into two separate cheer groups to take turns cheering at the games or to cover additional games. Please be flexible.

The Cumberland Valley Youth Cheer Association offers a unique cheerleading program that allows all interested children to be cheerleaders. Our association has a “no-cut” policy and offers different levels of participation depending on age, level of interest, and experience. All participants are assigned to a team. In an effort to help you make an informed decision regarding the best “team fit” for your child and your family, please examine the team profiles below.

Practices for the Rookie, Mini, Pee Wee, and Pony Cheer teams will begin on Thurs, Aug. 1st. All teams will practice at Good Hope Middle School on August 1, 6, 13, 14, and 15 from 6 pm to 7:30 pm. We highly recommend carpooling for all participants. This will make cheerleading more enjoyable for you and your child. During the month of June, tumbling evaluations will be held on Monday evenings at USA Stars for the oldest children in Minis, Pee Wees and Ponies to determine placement on a team. Cheerleaders will be placed on teams **based on tumbling skills and the level of interest of the parents**. During the cheerleading registration process, parents will have the opportunity to submit a cheerleading interest form indicating permission for your child to be evaluated for a specific team. The team level you select for your child will indicate that you understand the responsibilities and commitment level required for your child’s participation at that level. I understand the responsibilities and commitment required for my child's participation in the CVYCA program and the team she is assigned. Although CVYCA has a no-cut policy and all children are placed on a team, I realize that my **child's tumbling skills will be a key factor in her team placement**. Tumbling will be evaluated during the June tumbling sessions at USA Stars. June 24th will be the final day for tumbling evaluations. If my child will be away on vacation, Monday, June 24th I will contact Nicole Seibert or Heather Homan so my child may be evaluated earlier in June. If my child at age 6, 8, 10, or 12 years of age has the required tumbling skill to advance, I will be consulted to see if I want my child to remain on the age-appropriate team or moved up one age group where she can perform the skill she has mastered in competition.

- If a 6-year-old (1st grader) consistently executes a back walkover or handspring at USA Stars on Mon, June 24, she is eligible to move to Minis.
- If an 8-year old (3rd grader) consistently executes a back walkover during June tumbling sessions, she is eligible to move to Pee Wees and would be placed on Pee Wee Red (Pee Wee Level 1).
- If an 8-year old (3rd grader) consistently executes a back handspring during June tumbling sessions, she is eligible to move to Pee Wees and would be placed on Pee Wee White (Pee Wee Level 2).
- If a 10-year-old (5th grader) consistently executes a back handspring during June tumbling sessions, she is eligible to move to Ponies.
- If a 12-year-old (7th grader) consistently executes a tumbling pass with a tuck, she is eligible to try out for junior high cheerleading.

Also, cheerleaders may be asked to temporarily assist another team or permanently join a different team if openings become available due to illness, injury, resignation or if the number of members on a team is insufficient to be competitive. These situations may happen during any part of the season but typically are handled during the summer months before competitions begin or after competitions conclude for the fall teams. We ask that all cheerleaders and parents be supportive of these changes.
